Supplemental 2016 Congressional Art Competition Guidelines

- Each student may only enter one piece of artwork.
- Each participating student must complete the student information and release form: <http://reichert.house.gov/serving-you/art-competition> by April 15, 2016 and sent to the Issaquah office to Jacques Imperial by e-mail: Jacques.Imperial@mail.house.gov or fax: 425.270.3589.
- Artwork must already be framed.
- Artwork must have wire hangers – no sawtooth hangers.
- There is a possibility that artwork, frames, and glass may be damaged or broken during the course of the competition. Congressman Reichert's office is not responsible for these damages.
- Student must deliver artwork to Lake Wilderness Lodge on April 22, 2016 between 8AM – 12PM. For students residing east of Snoqualmie Pass, please deliver to our Wenatchee office by April 20, 2016.
- A student must be present at the reception at Lake Wilderness Lodge to win on April 22, 2016 at 3:30PM.
- Students must pick up their artwork at the conclusion of the reception on April 22, 2016, or it will be subject to disposal.

In the case of the winner, artwork must be picked up within 30 days of the student being notified that our district office has received it from Washington, D.C.
